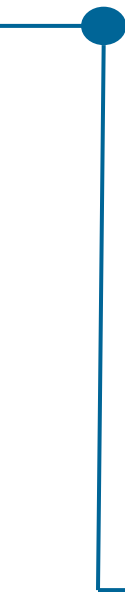

Background

- 2018: Bike Share Pilot (Lime)
- 2024: Comprehensive Plan Policies (Transportation):
TR-105: Support the establishment and operation of a shared micromobility service in Bellevue.
- 2025: Code amended to accommodate electric scooters
- 2026: Lime selected as preferred micromobility vendor

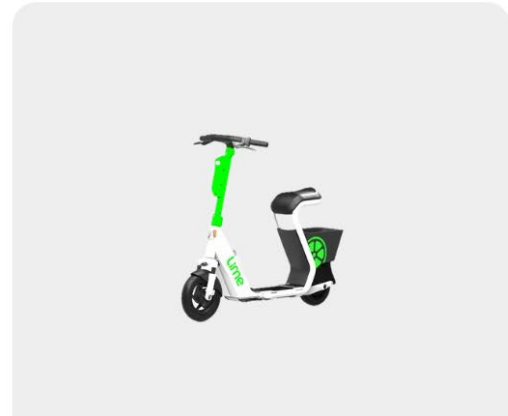

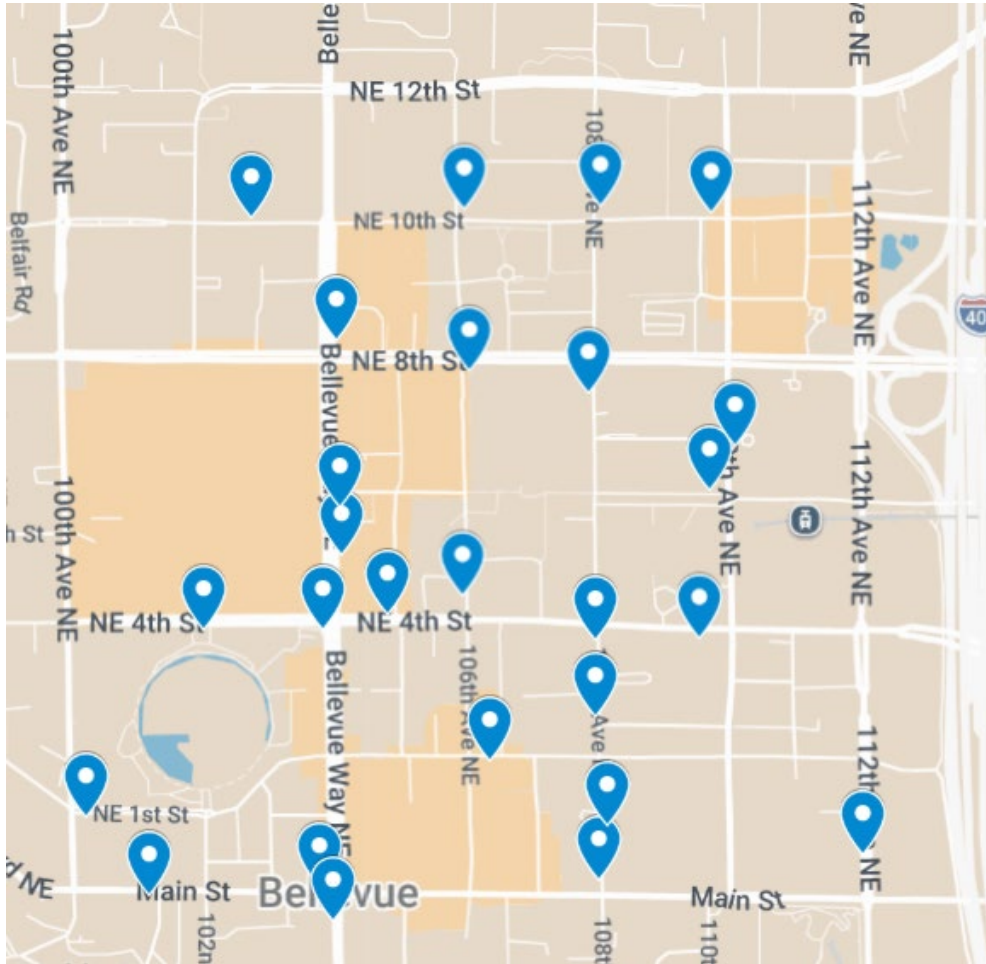

Corral Locations in the Downtown

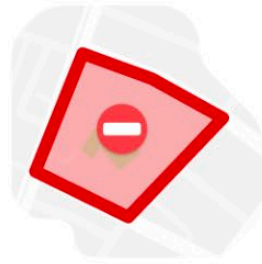

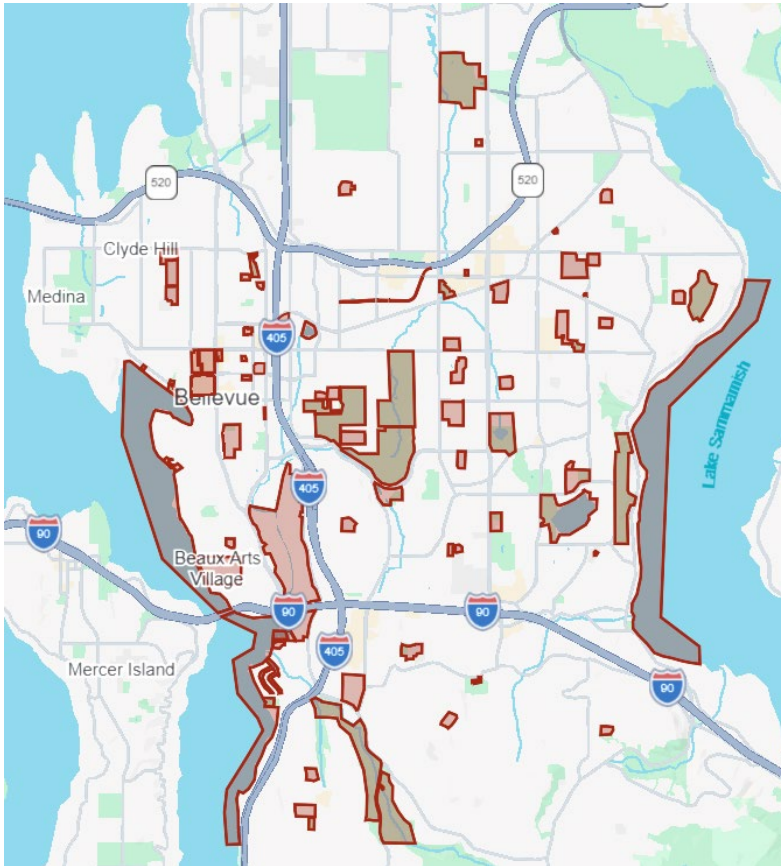

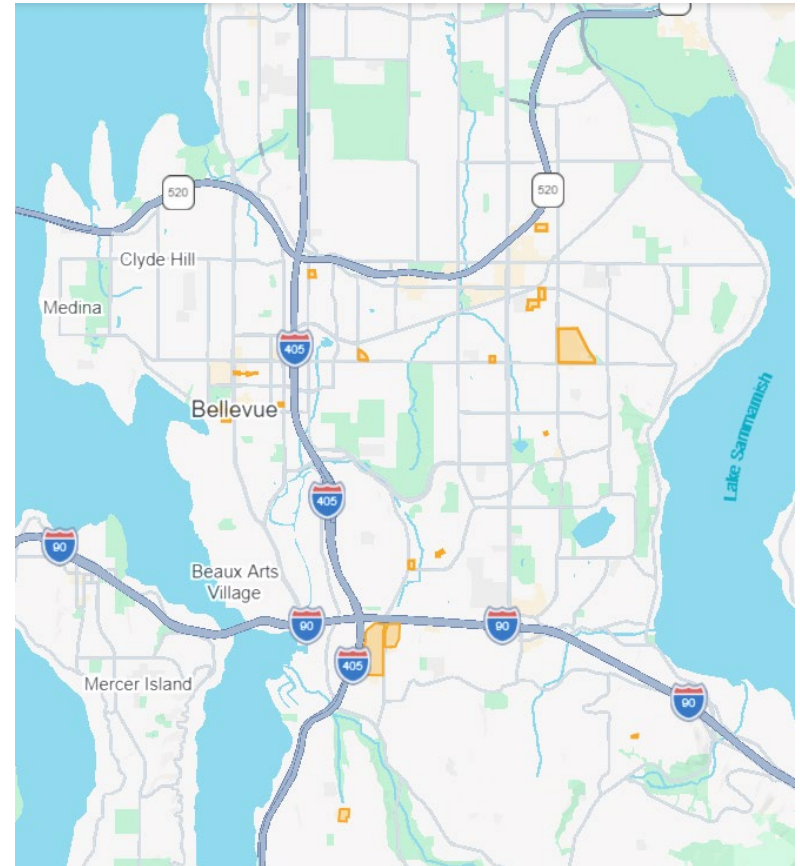

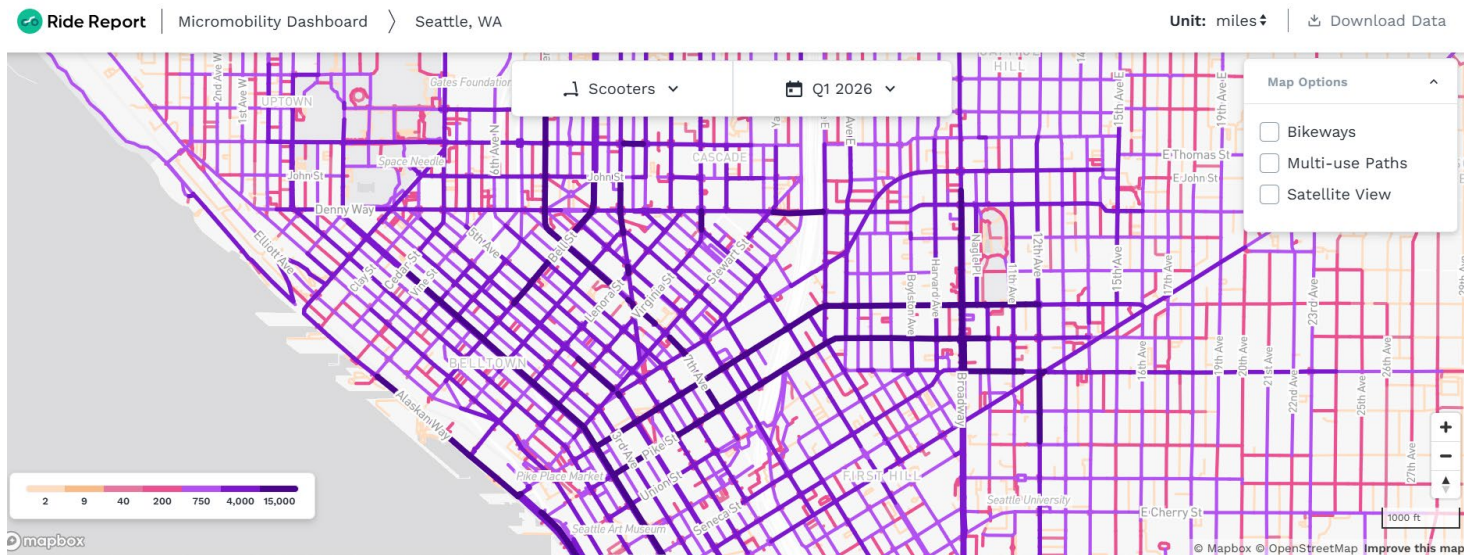
