

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 6923

AN ORDINANCE 1) authorizing execution of an Interlocal Agreement (and supplements if necessary) with King County Metro (KCM) for an agreement totaling \$607,731, which includes a contribution of \$467,485 in pass-through federal grant funds from KCM for the 2026-2027 Transportation Demand Management (TDM) Implementation Program; and 2) amending the 2025-2026 Operating Grants, Donations and Special Reserves Fund by increasing the appropriation by \$233,743.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute an Interlocal Agreement (and supplements if necessary) with King County Metro (KCM) for an agreement totaling \$607,731, which includes a contribution of \$467,485 in pass-through federal grant funds from KCM for the 2026-2027 Transportation Demand Management (TDM) Implementation Program; and 2) amending the 2025-2026 Operating Grants, Donations and Special Reserves Fund by increasing the appropriation by \$233,743, a copy of which agreement shall be substantially in the form given Clerk's Receiving No. _____.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said grant agreement.

Section 3. The City Manager or his designee shall have responsibility for the administration of said funds and expenditure of said funds received pursuant to said Grant Agreement and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 4. At the time of execution of said Grant Agreement and acceptance of said funds, a project shall be established within the Operating Grants, Donations and Special Reserves Fund into which all said respective monies shall be deposited.

Section 5. The approximate amount and anticipated source of revenue for said grant monies is:

Section 6. Upon execution of said Grant Agreement, the budget for the 2025-2026 Operating Grants, Donations, and Special Reserve Fund, shall be amended by appropriating \$140,246 to said fund.

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the anticipated sources specified in said Grant Agreement shall be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriations shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 7. The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute a professional services contract amendment (and supplements if necessary) with King County Metro (KCM) for an agreement totaling \$607,731, to accept pass-through federal funding for the city's 2026-2027 TDM program activities for worker/resident, business and student outreach, a copy of which amendment shall be substantially in the form given Clerks Receiving No. _____.

Section 8. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.
