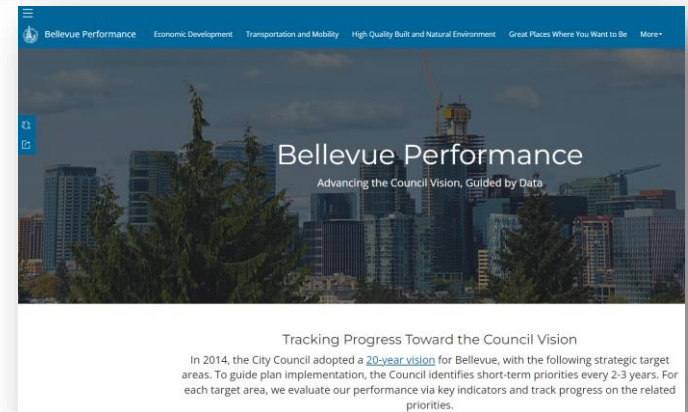
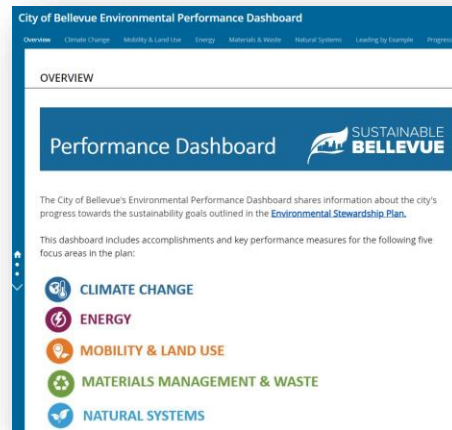
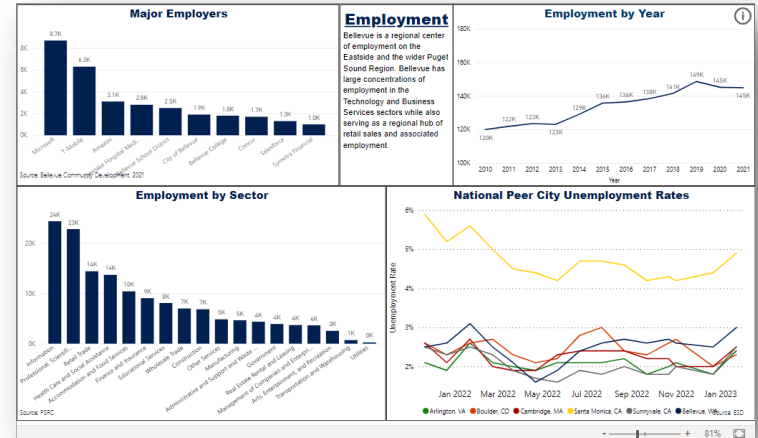
Leverage data and technology to enhance community engagement, equity, and accountability.

- Set up a dashboard to continuously report on progress against council priorities/vision



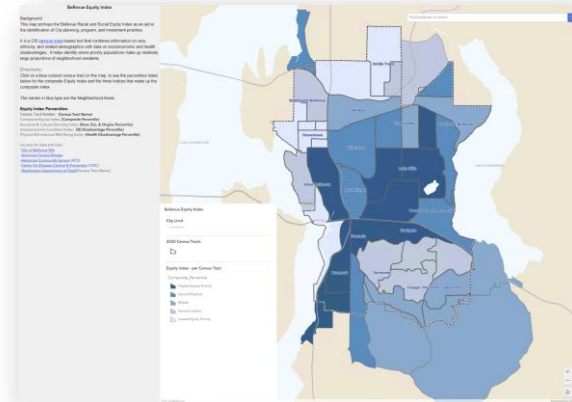
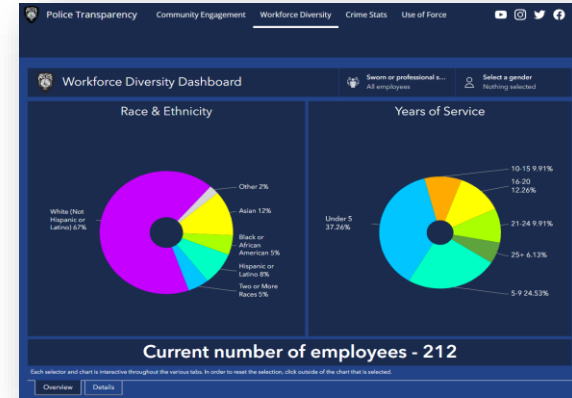

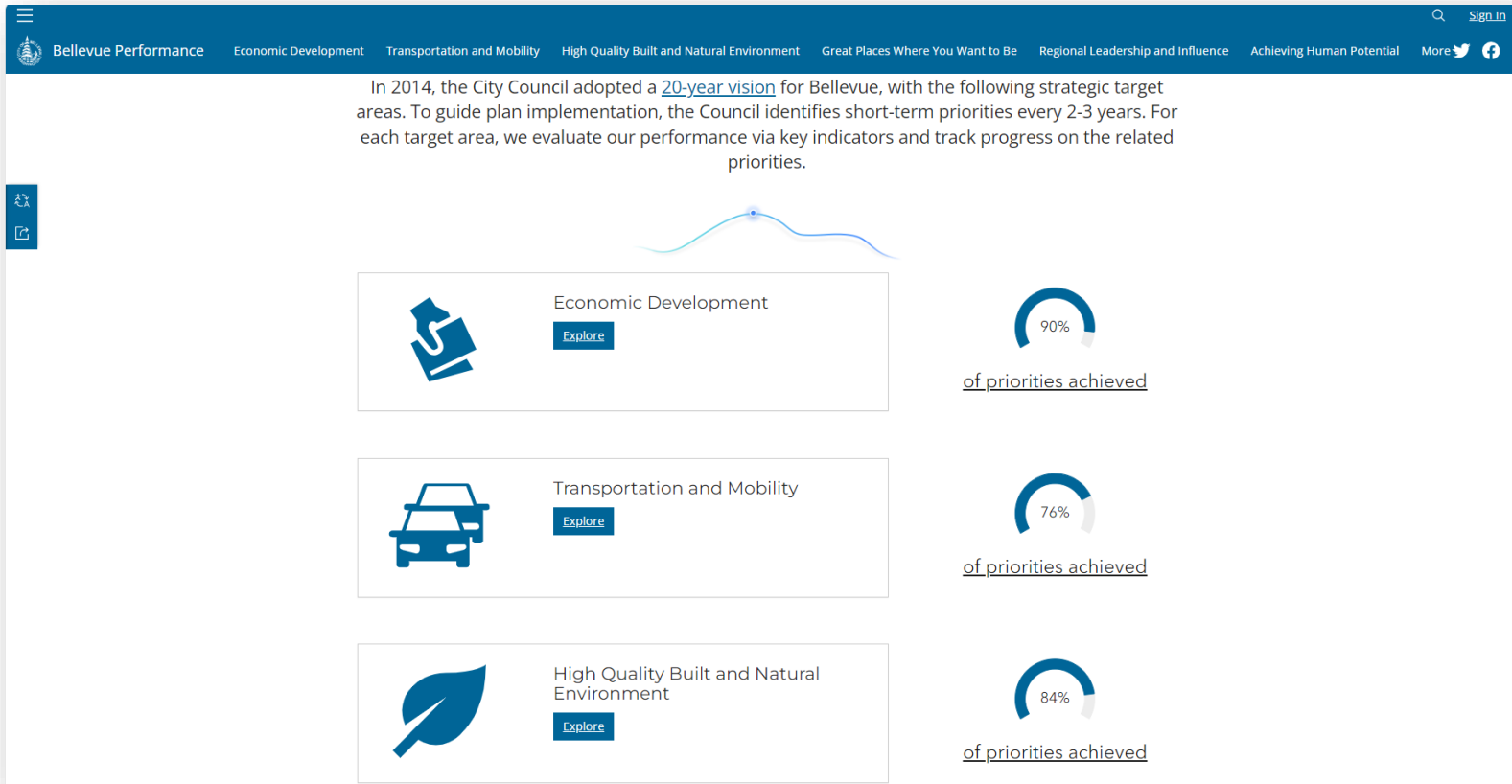
