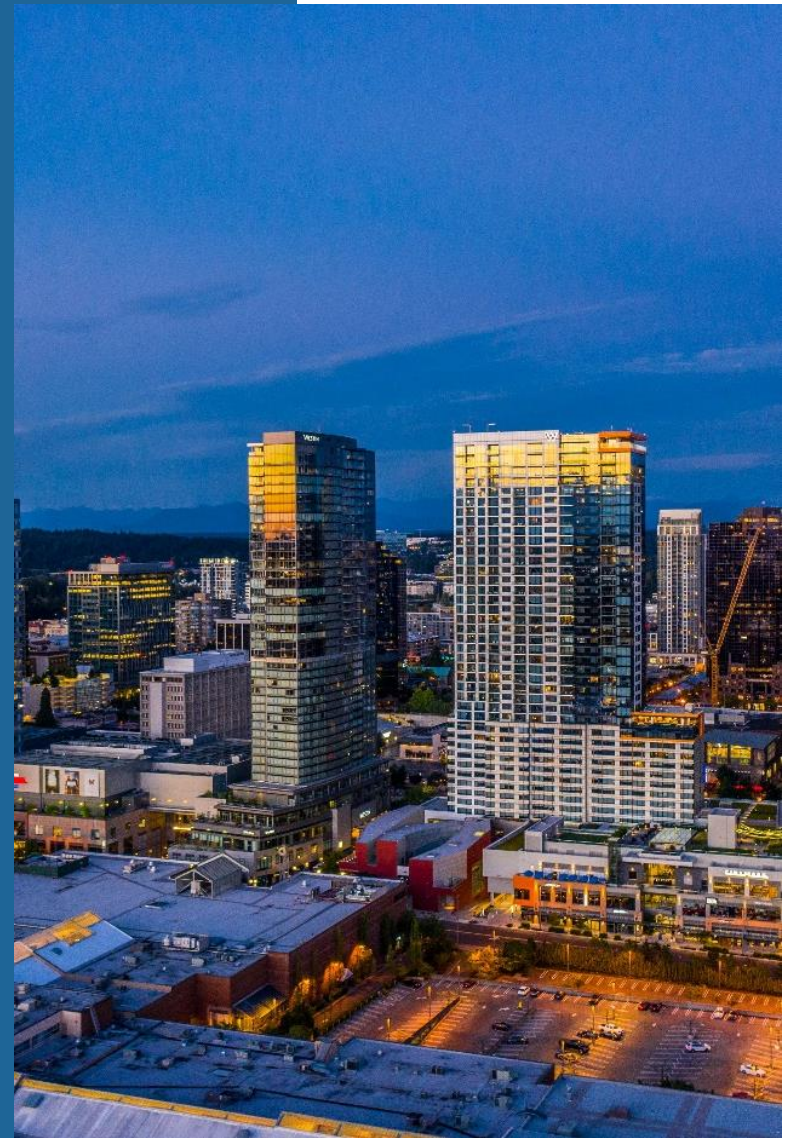

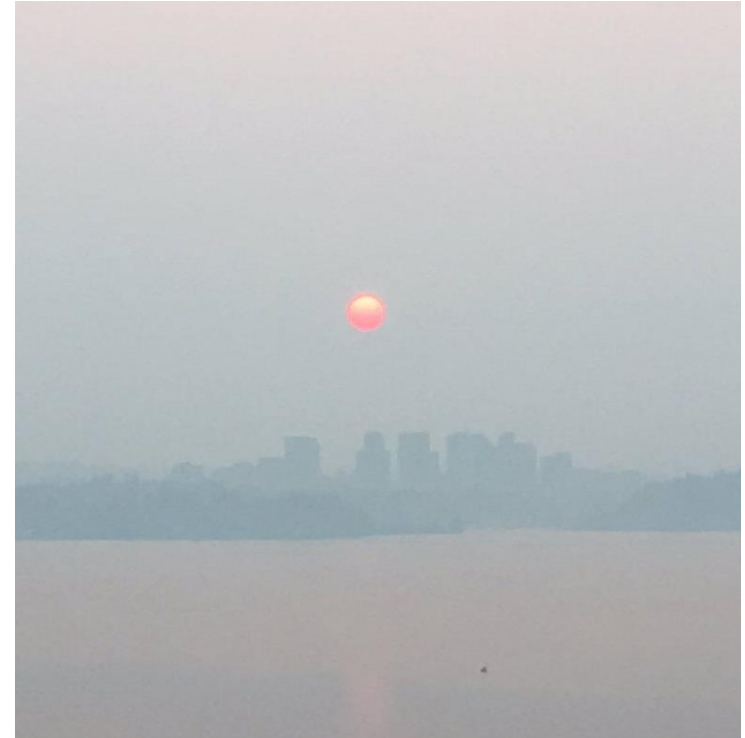

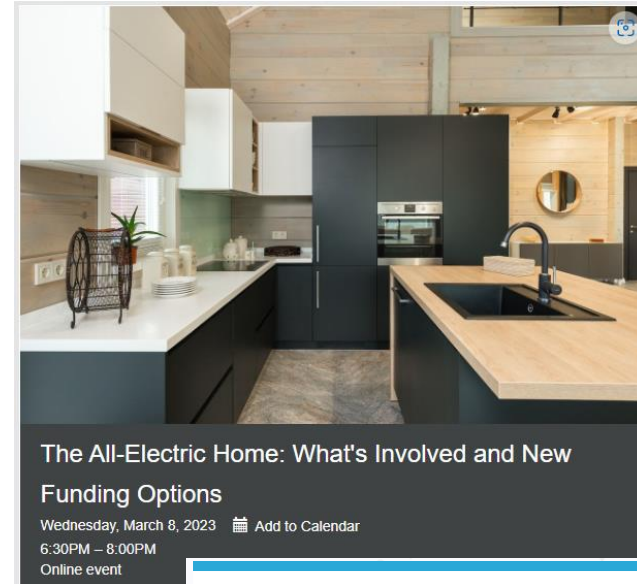

Time: Doors open at 5:30pm, event goes from 6 - 8 p.m.

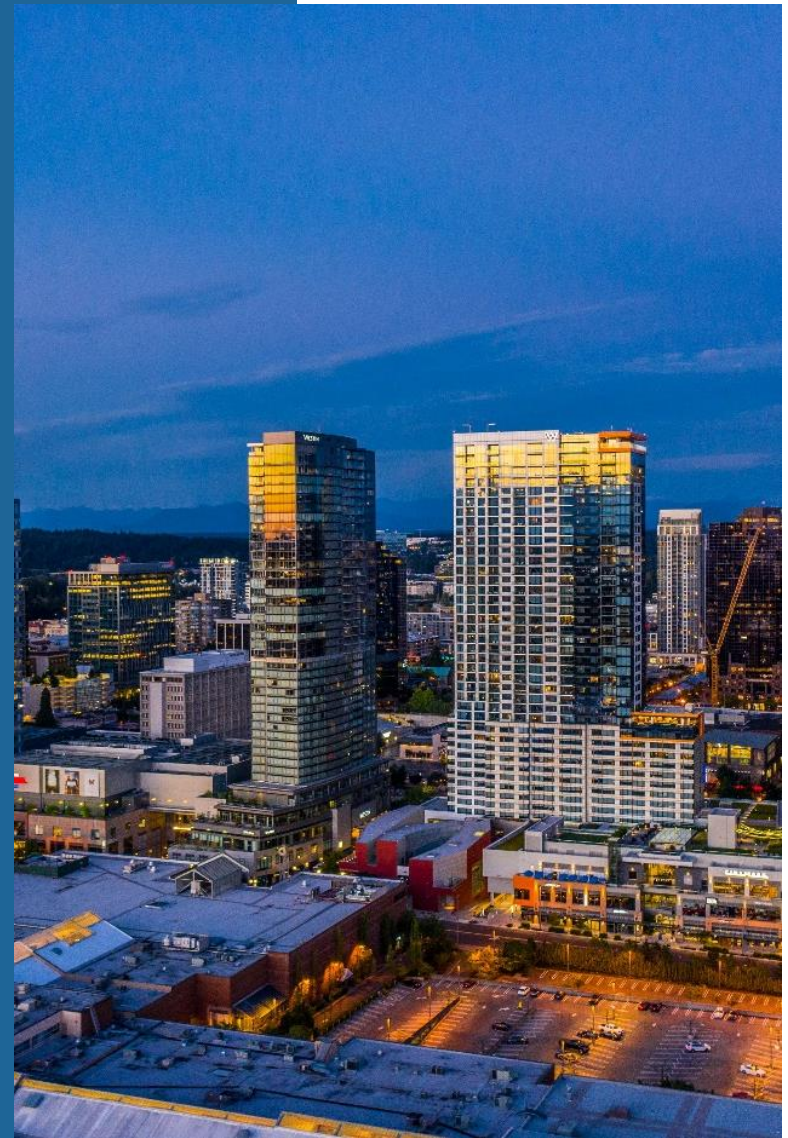
