

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 6860

AN ORDINANCE 1) approving an update of the City of Bellevue Commute Trip Reduction (CTR) Plan for 2025 through 2029; 2) authorizing execution of a two-year interlocal funding agreement (and supplements if necessary) with the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) to accept up to \$515,000.00 of state funds to support the City of Bellevue's CTR Program; and, 3) amending the 2025-2026 Operating Grants, Donations and Special Reserves Fund to increase the appropriation by \$515,000.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or designee is authorized to approve an update of the City of Bellevue Commute Trip (CTR) Plan for 2025 through 2029, a copy of which update shall be substantially in the form given Clerk's Receiving No. \_\_\_\_\_.

Section 2. The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute a two-year interlocal funding agreement (and supplements if necessary) with the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) to accept up to \$515,000.00 of state funds to support the City of Bellevue's CTR Program, a copy of which agreement shall be substantially in the form given Clerk's Receiving No. \_\_\_\_\_.

Section 3. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said agreement and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 4. The City manager or designee shall have responsibility for the administration of said funds and expenditure of said funds received pursuant to said Grant Agreement and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regards the use thereof.

Section 5. At the time of execution of said Grant Agreement and acceptance of said funds, a project shall be established within the Operating Grants, Donations and Special Reserve Fund into which all said respective grant monies shall be deposited.

Section 6. The approximate amount and anticipated source of revenue for said grant monies is:

Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT)	\$515,000
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Section 7. Upon execution of said Grant Agreement, the budget for the 2025-2026 Operating Grants, Donations and Special Reserve Fund shall be amended by appropriating \$515,000 to said fund.

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the anticipated source specified in said agreement shall be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriations shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 8. Severability. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining parts of this Ordinance.

Section 9. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.
