SUBJECT: City of Bellevue 2026 State Legislative Agenda and Walking Tour

During the Special Council meeting on December 8, 2025, the Bellevue City Council and staff will present the City's 2026 State Legislative Agenda to legislators from the 41st and 48th legislative districts. The meeting will outline key legislative priorities including economic prosperity and partnership, affordable housing, streamlined permitting and transportation investments. The meeting will also provide an opportunity to hear directly from legislators about their priorities for the upcoming session. This discussion supports the Council's Strategic Target Area of High Performance Government by reinforcing the importance of a clear and effective state legislative agenda for 2026.

Following the meeting, participants will join a walking tour of the Bellevue Grand Connection from City Hall Plaza to Bellevue Way. The tour may be adjusted to accommodate inclement weather.
