

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 6884

AN ORDINANCE authorizing 1) the execution of an agreement with Hughes Fire Equipment, Inc. to purchase two replacement fire ladder trucks for the Bellevue Fire Department, in an amount not to exceed \$5,077,861, plus all applicable taxes, and 2) amending the 2025-2026 adopted budget to increase appropriation to the Equipment Rental Fund by \$5,077,861.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute an agreement with Hughes Fire Equipment, Inc. to purchase two replacement fire ladder trucks for the Bellevue Fire Department, in an amount not to exceed \$5,077,861, plus all applicable taxes, a copy of which agreement shall be substantially in the form given Clerk's Receiving No. _____.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said agreement and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 3. The 2025-2026 Biennial Budget adopted by Ordinance No. 6822 on November 19, 2024, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase appropriation to the Equipment Rental Fund by \$5,077,861.

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the anticipated source specified in said agreement shall be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriations shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 4. Severability. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining parts of this Ordinance.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.
