CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON ORDINANCE NO. 6873

AN ORDINANCE authorizing execution of a grant agreement with the U.S. Department of Homeland Security FEMA to accept \$382,654.72 in Assistance to Firefighters Grant funding for Peer Support Team training; amending the 2025-2026 budget of the Operating, Grants, Donations and Special Reserves Fund; and authorizing expenditures of said grant funds.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute a Grant Agreement with the U.S. Department of Homeland Security FEMA to accept \$382,654.72 in Assistance to Firefighters Grant funding for Peer Support Team training, a copy of which agreement shall be substantially in the form given Clerk's Receiving No.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said Grant Agreement and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 3. At the time of execution of said Grant Agreement and acceptance of said funds, a project shall be established within the Operating Grants, Donations and Special Reserves Fund into which all said respective grant monies shall be deposited.

Section 4. The approximate amount and anticipated source of revenue for said grant monies is:

U.S. Department of Homeland Security FEMA \$382,654.72

Section 5. Upon execution of said Grant Agreement, the budget for the 2025-2026 Operating Grants, Donations and Special Reserves Fund shall be amended by appropriating \$382,654.72 to said fund.

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the anticipated source specified in said agreement shall be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriations shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 6. <u>Severability</u>. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining parts of this Ordinance.
