EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**ACTION**

This Resolution authorizes the purchase and installation of new play equipment at Lewis Creek Community Park, including demolition of existing play equipment by KCDA, for an amount not to exceed \$510,836 plus all applicable taxes.

RECOMMENDATION

Move to adopt Resolution No. 10640

BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

The current play equipment at Lewis Creek Park was installed 21 years ago in 2005 when the park was built and has reached the end of its useful life cycle. City staff selected the proposed new play equipment after working with Lewis Creek staff and a design team to incorporate several inclusive elements that meet the local needs for the budget available. The accessible components of the play structures include more than six inclusive elements accessible by ground, 10 raised components accessible by transfer platform, and sensory play elements throughout the two different play area zones.

The new playground also incorporates the use of synthetic turf fall surfacing which will benefit all. This playground, while maximizing inclusive elements, will be a great addition for all park users for many years to come. The proposed Lewis Creek Community Park Playground meets and exceeds the requirements of the DOJ 2010 ADA Standards for Accessible Design.

The purchase will utilize a cooperative purchasing agreement with KCDA which allows the city to secure competitive pricing.

POLICY & FISCAL IMPACTS**Policy Impact**

Bellevue City Code Chapter 4.28 provides for the fair and equitable treatment of all persons involved in the purchasing process. Council approval is required to execute a contract in excess of \$350,000.

Fiscal Impact

This action obligates the city to an amount not to exceed \$510,836, plus all applicable taxes. This project is funded in the 2025-2030 General Capital Improvement Program (CIP) in the Parks Renovation & Refurbishment Plan (CIP Plan No. P-R-11).

OPTIONS

1. Adopt the Resolution authorizing the purchase and installation of new play equipment at Lewis Creek Community Park, and demolition of existing play equipment utilizing the cooperative agreement pricing through the King County Directors Association (KCDA) with equipment made by AllPlay, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$510,836, plus all applicable taxes.
