


Park & Open Space Acquisition



This project provides resources to acquire park and open space property throughout the city. The overall goal is to acquire land that complements the existing park system, increase public access to the waterfront, preserve open space and natural areas, protect water quality, increase trail connectivity, and create opportunities for new neighborhood parks. The 2022 Parks & Open Space System Plan identifies needs throughout Bellevue to provide additional parks and open space. Specific acquisition targets include, but are not limited to neighborhood properties that increase walkable access to parks for the Eastgate, Factoria and Crossroads neighborhoods; properties that promote access to the Eastrail Corridor and other greenways; properties that expand parks acreage in urban or redeveloping areas such as Downtown, BelRed and Wilburton; properties that increase waterfront access, such as along Lake Sammamish; and acquisitions that support the Grand Connection.
