



What does this mean for Bellevue?

Forecast Takeaways

- 2025 forecast on par with 2024 forecast.
- Policy uncertainty poses forecast risk.
- Weakened consumer confidence, instability, and rising costs may lower City revenues.
- Inflation is stubbornly persistent.
- Construction pipeline stable an interest rate cut 2026 could boost growth.
- Major revenue growth unlikely before 2027.
