ORDINANCE NO. 6784

AN ORDINANCE 1) amending the 2023-2029 CIP Plan to increase the budget for the Fire Station 10 (Levy) Project (CIP Plan No. PS-64) by \$10,200,000; 2) decreasing the budget for the Fire Station 4 (Levy) Project (CIP Plan No. PS-65) by \$5,100,000; and 3) decreasing the budget for the Fire Warehouse & Special Projects (Levy) Project (CIP Plan No. PS-67) by \$5,100,000.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The 2023-2029 Capital Investment Project (CIP) Plan, adopted by Ordinance 6689 on November 21, 2022, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the budget for the Fire Station 10 Project (CIP Plan No. PS-64) by \$10,200,000;

Section 2. The 2023-2029 CIP Plan, adopted by Ordinance 6689 on November 21, 2022, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to decrease the budget for the Fire Station 4 Project (CIP Plan No. PS-65) by \$5,100,000;

Section 3. The 2023-2029 CIP Plan, adopted by Ordinance 6689 on November 21, 2022, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to decrease the budget for the Fire Warehouse & Special Projects Project (CIP Plan No. PS-67) by \$5,100,000;

Section 4. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining parts of this Ordinance.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.
