- Whereas:** Walk & Roll to School Day in October continues to encourage children to safely walk or roll to school or to the school bus, while supporting the growth of Safe Routes to School programs across the United States and around the world; and
- Whereas:** all children benefit when communities work to improve the safety of people walking and rolling; and
- Whereas:** walking and rolling to school provides important opportunities for children to be physically active and spend time outdoors, supporting their overall health and well-being; and
- Whereas:** parents and caregivers play an important role in teaching children about safety when traveling to school, and in encouraging healthy habits that will last a lifetime; and
- Whereas:** choosing to walk or roll as modes of transportation can help reduce traffic congestion and provide environmental benefits for the entire community; and
- Whereas:** this year's Walk & Roll event is coordinated by Bellevue SchoolPool, a partnership between the City of Bellevue, King County Metro and the Bellevue School District, encouraging families and students to explore safe, healthy and sustainable transportation options.
