SUBJECT: Analysis of the Human Services Funding Awards to Improve Equity in Funding

Staff will provide an overview of the analysis of the 2023 Human Services Funding awards, which includes reviewing funds to BIPOC By and For Agencies, funding for new agencies, funding for Eastside-born and Eastside-based agencies, and other efforts related to improving equity in funding.

## **Background**

Human Services began formally analyzing their funding recommendation for equity in funding starting in 2021 and has continued this work annually. The goal of the analysis is to highlight areas of progress related to equity in funding and to identify opportunities for improvement.
