## ORDINANCE NO. 6800

AN ORDINANCE 1) authorizing an increase in the construction contract with Active Construction, Inc. (ACI) (Bid No. 22000) by \$2,303,209.05 for a total contract amount of \$25,449,039.05 plus all applicable taxes, for the 124<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE - Ichigo to Northup Way Project (CIP Plan No. PW-R-191); and, 2) amending the 2023-2029 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) Plan to decrease the budget for the 130<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE – Bel-Red Road to NE 20<sup>th</sup> Street (CIP Plan No. PW-R-170) by \$2,100,000.00; 124<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE – NE 12<sup>th</sup> Street to NE Spring Boulevard (CIP Plan No. PW-R-169) by \$1,000,000.00; and NE Spring Boulevard, 130<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE to 132<sup>nd</sup> Avenue NE (CIP Plan No. PW-R-174) by \$400,000.00; and increase the budget for the 124<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE - Ichigo to Northup Way Project (CIP Plan No. PW-R-191) by \$3,500,000.00.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or designee is authorized to increase the construction contract with Active Construction, Inc. (ACI) (Bid No. 22000) by \$2,303,209.05 for a total contract amount of \$25,449,039.05 plus all applicable taxes, for the 124<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE - Ichigo to Northup Way Project (CIP Plan No. PW-R-191).

Section 2. The 2023-2029 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) Plan adopted by Ordinance No. 6698 on November 21, 2022, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to decrease the budget for the 130<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE – Bel-Red Road to NE 20<sup>th</sup> Street (CIP Plan No. PW-R-170) by \$2,100,000.00; 124<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE – NE 12<sup>th</sup> Street to NE Spring Boulevard (CIP Plan No. PW-R-169) by \$1,000,000.00; and NE Spring Boulevard, 130<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE to 132<sup>nd</sup> Avenue NE (CIP Plan No. PW-R-174) by \$400,000.00; and increase the budget for the 124<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE - Ichigo to Northup Way Project (CIP Plan No. PW-R-191) by \$3,500,000.00.

Section 3. Severability. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining parts of this Ordinance.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.
