Consideration of the Hearing Examiner's Recommendation on the application a) 16-115 of Demian Minjarez of SMR Architects to rezone a 4.3 acre site located within the North Bellevue Subarea from R-2.5 to R-20, to be consistent with the recently approved Comprehensive Plan Amendment #15-103696 AC. The property is located at St. Luke's Lutheran Church between NE 29th Street and

NE 32nd Place at 3030 Bellevue Way. Permit file number 15-103697 LQ.
