- b) [ORD 6379](#) Ordinance relating to speed limits; amending Section 11.32.020 of the Bellevue City Code to establish a speed limit of 30 mph for 120th Avenue NE between NE 4th Street and NE Bellevue-Redmond Road and to reduce the speed limit for NE Bellevue-Redmond Road between 120th Avenue NE and 124th Avenue NE to 25 mph.
