

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 6617

AN ORDINANCE (1) authorizing execution of a two-year interagency agreement with the Department of Ecology for a Stormwater Best Management Practices Study in the amount of \$193,520, with the executed interagency agreement to be substantially in the form as the agreement in the Council Library; and (2) amending the 2021-2022 Operating Grants, Donations and Special Reserves Fund to increase the appropriation by \$79,393 to cover the anticipated expenditures in this biennium.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager, or his designee, is authorized to execute a two-year interagency agreement with the Department of Ecology for a Stormwater Best Management Practices Study in the amount of \$193,520. The executed interagency agreement shall be substantially in the form of the agreement in the Council Library, a copy of which agreement has been given Clerk's Receiving No. _____.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in the interagency agreement referenced in Section 1.

Section 3. Upon execution of the interagency agreement and acceptance of the funds as described in Section 1, a project shall be established within the Operating Grants, Donations, and Special Reserves Fund into which all said monies shall be deposited.

Section 4. The City's 2021-2022 Operating Grants, Donations, and Special Reserves Fund appropriation adopted by Ordinance No. 6557 on December 14, 2020, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the appropriation by \$79,393 to cover the anticipated expenditures in this biennium; provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the anticipated sources specified in the interagency agreement referenced in Section 1 shall be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriations to the Operating Grants, Donations, and Special Reserves Fund shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after passage and legal publication
