ORDINANCE NO. 6639

AN ORDINANCE authorizing (1) execution of a second amendment to a professional services agreement with Carollo Engineers LLC (# 2050010), for Lake Washington Sewer Lake Line Management Plan (CIP Plan Nos. S-58 and S-71), to increase the contract value in an amount not to exceed \$1,338,456, plus all applicable taxes, and to extend the term of the agreement until January 22, 2024; (2) amendment of the 2021-2027 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) Plan to transfer \$890,000 of budget from the Sewer Renewal and Replacement Fund (CIP Plan No. S-96) to the Lake Line Management Plan (CIP Plan No. S-58); and (3) amendment of the 2021-2027 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) Plan to transfer remaining \$20,648 of budget from the Utilities Lakeline Sewer Replacement (CIP Plan No. S-71) to the Lake Line Management Plan (CIP Plan No. S-58).

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute a second amendment to a professional services agreement with Carollo Engineers LLC (# 2050010), for Lake Washington Sewer Lake Line Management Plan (CIP Plan S-58 & S-71), to increase the contract value in an amount not to exceed \$1,338,456, plus all applicable taxes, and to extend the term of the agreement until January 22, 2024, a copy of which amendment has been given Clerk's Receiving No. ________.

Section 2. The City's 2021-2027 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) Plan, adopted by Ordinance 6622 on November 22, 2021, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to authorize the transfer of \$890,000 of budget from the Sewer Renewal and Replacement Fund (CIP Plan No. S-96) to the Lake Line Management Plan (CIP Plan No. S-58).

Section 3. The City's 2021-2027 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) Plan, adopted by Ordinance 6622 on November 22, 2021, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to authorize the transfer of \$20,648 from the Utilities Lakeline Sewer Replacement (CIP Plan No. S-71) to the Lake Line Management Plan (CIP Plan No. S-58).

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.
