Firefighting 101 Women's Workshop

36 attendees received instruction from an allfemale training team on the following skills:

- Starting chainsaws
- Carrying 24' ladders, throw straight ladders
- Use of the irons (halligan and flathead axe) for forcible entry
- Taking a hydrant
- Practice dragging a 165-pound mannequin
- Climb the tower with a hose bundle

- 2-Day Event for Girls Ages 12-18
- Summer 2022 (pending loosening of restrictions)
- Female Firefighter Instructors
- Hands-on Introduction to Fire and EMS skills
- Develop confidence and leadership skills
