RESOLUTION NO. 10058

A RESOLUTION adopting "Newport Hills Woodlawn Park" as the name for the new park in the Newport Hills Neighborhood located at 11560 SE 60th Street.

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 8229 sets forth the policy and procedure for naming public parks and recreation facilities, whereby the City Council designates the names of public parks and park or recreation facilities, and may seek a recommendation from the Parks and Community Services Board ("Parks Board), which is based on public input from individuals and organizations;

WHEREAS, on September 14, 2021, the Parks Board recommended the name "Newport Hills Woodland Park" for the new park in the Newport Hills Neighborhood located at 11560 SE 60th Street;

WHERES, on December 13, 2021, Council reviewed the process, deliberation, community survey results, and Parks Board recommendation and selected "Newport Hills Woodlawn Park" for the new park in the Newport Hills Neighborhood and directed staff to return with a resolution adopting this name;

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. "Newport Hills Woodlawn Park" is hereby adopted as the name for the new park in the Newport Hills Neighborhood located at 11560 SE 60th Street.

Section 2. The City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized to execute all documents necessary to approve and authorize the adoption of the name "Newport Hills Woodlawn Park" for the new park in the Newport Hills Neighborhood.
