SUBJECT:	Public Hearing and Final Approval – Repeal the Comprehensive Transportation Project List, Ordinance No. 6632

I. Introduction

On February 1, 2022, the East Bellevue Community Council (EBCC) will hold a public hearing and take action on Ordinance No. 6632 (Attachment A) adopted by the City Council on December 13, 2021 to repeal the Comprehensive Transportation Project List from Volume 2 of the Comprehensive Plan.

II. Discussion

As part of the 2021 annual amendments to the Comprehensive Plan, the City Council initiated the process to repeal the Comprehensive Transportation Project List (CTPL) from Volume 2 of the Comprehensive Plan. Instead the Transportation Improvement Program would be the one citywide inventory of transportation projects.

On June 23, 2021 the Planning Commission held a study session on the Transportation Department staff recommendation to repeal the CTPL. Following a public hearing on July 28, 2021 the Planning Commisison transmitted a recommendation to the City Council. On July 6, 2021, the EBCC held a courtesy hearing and discussed the recommended repeal of the CTPL.

In a study session on October 25, 2021, the City Council reviewed the Planning Commission recommendation and directed staff to prepare an ordinance for adoption. Council adopted Ordinance No. 6632 on December 13, 2021 to repeal the CTPL.

III. Action requested of the EBCC

Following tonight's public hearing, the EBCC is requested to adopt Resolution No. 601 approving City Council Ordinance No. 6632. Transportation Department staff will be present at the public hearing to answer questions.
