CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO.6658

AN ORDINANCE 1) authorizing execution of an Interagency Agreement with the Department of Commerce and acceptance of grant funds in the amount of \$100,000 to support implementation of the City's Affordable Housing Strategy, and 2) amending the 2021-2022 Operating Grants, Donations, and Special Reserve Fund to increase the appropriation by \$100,000; providing for severability; and establishing an effective date.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute an Interagency Agreement with the Department of Commerce and to accept grant funds in the amount of \$100,000 to support implementation of the City's Affordable Housing Strategy. A copy of the Interagency Agreement with the Department of Commerce, as authorized by this Ordinance, shall be substantially in the form given Clerk's Receiving No. _____.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said Interagency Agreement.

Section 3. The City Manager or his designee shall have responsibility for the administration of said funds and expenditure of said funds received pursuant to said Interagenacy Agreement and, consistent with the terms of the Interagency Agreement, shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 4. The 2021-2022 General Fund Budget, adopted by Ordinance 6622 on November 22, 2021 and as previously amended, is further amended to increase the appropriation to the Operating Grants, Donations, and Special Reserves Fund by \$100,000.

Section 5. <u>Severability</u>. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining parts of this Ordinance.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.
