EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Traffic marking maintenance and repair is an important factor in safe public roadways. Meeting the designed performance measures of these systems emphasizes the City Council Vision and Priorities for Transportation and Mobility.

RECOMMENDATION

Move to adopt Resolution No. 10098

BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

This agreement will provide replacement of worn or otherwise damaged or missing crosswalks, directional arrows and raised pavement markers. These permanent repairs are needed to meet City standards, to reduce the probability of damages and claims, and to meet the City's customer service goals.

POLICY & FISCAL IMPACTS

Policy Impact

Transportation Comprehensive Plan

- TR 48: Maintain and enhance safety for all users of the roadway network.
- TR 49: Ensure that maintenance of the existing transportation system be given priority consideration.

Fiscal Impact

This Resolution commits the City to a three-year contract not to exceed \$325,000, plus all applicable taxes, for traffic marking maintenance and repair services. Sufficient funding exists in the 2022 Transportation Department Operating Budget to fully fund the first year of this contract. Additional funding associated with this contract will be requested in the 2023-2024 Budget and will be subject to final budget appropriation. The City is under no obligation to utilize services to the negotiated upper limit or a "not to exceed" amount.

OPTIONS
