I am excited that Bellevue city officials are considering building eight dedicated pickleball courts at Bellevue Airfield Park as presented by David Lai and Leslie Wang at the 6/14 Bellevue Parks Advisory Board Meeting. Thirty two people will be able to play in a space which would only accommodate eight if these were tennis courts.</p> <p>Besides supporting emotional and physical health, pickleball helps people forge new community bonds. It is being taught in detention centers. It helps the elderly improve mental and motor skills. And the learning curve is such that anyone can pick up a paddle and play, in any age group. It's easy to learn but tough to master, an aspect which continues to challenge players. The sport is growing so fast it is projected to exceed 20 million players by 2030. We will need your support to ensure the community has places to play.</p> <p>The great enthusiasm generated for the pickleball bill is a testament to the love pickleball players have for the sport and to the surging popularity of pickleball. At the pickleball bill signing, Governor Inslee told Senator Lovick that he was impressed by the large number of people and media present. The attendance was considerably less, he said, at his 17-billion-dollar transportation package signing.</p> <p>There are 700 tournaments in the U.S. each year, and tournaments are held in every corner of Washington. This year's Seattle Metro Pickleball Classic has 640 players, the largest in the state, and is projected by the Snohomish County Sports Commission to generate half a million dollars in economic impact. This tournament is so popular that players filled most available spots within forty-eight hours. Smaller tournaments of 125 players can also generate economic impacts in the \$100,000 range.</p> <p>I am involved in an effort to make pickleball an official school sport. Pickleball guru and former University of Kentucky women's basketball coach Dotti Berry said, "For women who have not been involved in a sport, pickleball gives them an opportunity to feel empowered, sometimes for the first time in their lives. It's a direct training ground for other things like learning how to succeed in business and how to work in a team environment. It's amazing what it does for them." We would like all children to have a chance to feel empowered through participation in a sport like pickleball, which requires less space than tennis, is easy to learn and uses relatively inexpensive equipment.</p>
