Process Timeline

June 9 -11

Council initiates LUCA

July 7 Notice of Application Published

July 14 Notice of Public Hearing Published August 1 Public Hearing and Adoption of Quasi Judicial LUCA Ordinance



Current Code

- Hearing Examiner (HE) makes decision for Process I
- HE makes recommendation for Process III
- Council hears Quasi-Judicial appeal
- Closed record- no new evidence
- Council reviews record for material and substantial evidence
- Council's decision may be appealed to Superior Court



Proposed LUCA

- Process I
 - HE holds evidentiary hearing & makes decision
 - No appeal to Council
 - Appeal filed in Superior Court
 - HE decision is final if no appeal filed



Proposed LUCA

- Process III (site-specific rezones)
 - No appeal of HE recommendation to Council
 - Council retains role to make final decision on rezone application
 - Council considers HE record and recommendation
 - Final decision of Council may be appealed to Superior Court



Benefits of Proposed LUCA

- Optimizes Council's legislative and policy-making role
- Promotes fair, independent and efficient land use decision-making
- Encourages meaningful public engagement when record is open for comment



Decision Criteria

- The amendment is consistent with the Comprehensive Plan; and
- The amendment enhances the public health, safety or welfare; and
- The amendment is not contrary to the best interest of the citizens and property owners of the City of Bellevue



Action

Make a finding of necessity, hold a public hearing, and adopt Ordinance No. 6673.
