Family Child Care Home. A child care service use located in the family residence, which provides regularly scheduled care for 12 or fewer children or as licensed or approved by the Washington State Department of Children, Youth, and Families per Chapter 43.216 RCW and Chapter 110-300 WAC, now or as hereafter amended, for periods of less than 24 hours. For the purposes of this definition, family residence means the dwelling unit occupied for living purposes by the child care provider which includes permanent provisions for living, sleeping, eating, cooking and sanitation.

C. Family Child Care Home in a Residence.

Family child care providers must obtain an operating license from the Department of Early LearningChildren, Youth, and Families (DCYF). Minimum licensing requirements can be found in Chapter 170-296 WAC. Family child care providers also must obtain a Registration Certificate from the City of Bellevue as required by Chapter 4.03 BCC (Tax Administrative Code). All family child care homes must comply with all applicable building and fireCity codes, including but not limited to the Tax Administrative Code, Chapter 4.03 BCC; Building and Fire Codes, Sign Code, Chapter 22B.10 BCC₁₇ and LUC provisions governing lot size, building dimensions, setbacks and lot coverage requirements for the zone in which they are located.
