# Background

- **Family Child Care Homes**

- Defined under LUC 20.50.020
- No more than 12 children (current code)
- Licensed by State
  - Dept. of Children, Youth, and Families (DCYF)

- **Senate Bill (SB) 5237**

- Provisions related to childcare, early learning
- Waiver to allow more than 12 children in home-based childcare
  - Authority granted to DCYF (RCW 43.216.692)
- Rules established by DCYF (WAC 110-300-0358) in January 2022
  - Criteria to be considered before waiver is granted
    - Floor area, staff-child ratios, etc.



# LUCA Components

## LUC 20.50.020

### Definitions

- Insert reference to state legislation
  - Chapter 43.216 RCW
  - Chapter 110-300 WAC
- Remove 24-hour time limit
  - Regulated by DCYF

## LUC 20.20.170.C

### Use Requirements

- Update references to state agencies, laws
- Clean up references to other codes

*All other existing requirements will remain.*
