



### Problem/Solution consensus

- More frequent bus service

## Problem/Solution disagreement

- How to reduce reliance on single-occupancy vehicles
- How to get to transit (wide variety of first mile/last mile solutions)
- Best mix of land uses to support walking/biking/transit

**Modify** Policies that need minor text

edits or major edit to reflect a


change in the intent or

**Move** Policies that fit better in another

Element







## **Regional Direction**


- Equity Identify policies that have had an inequitable impact of communities of color & create policy to remediate those impacts
- Housing Ensure that there is housing to meet a households at a variety of income levels in every neighborhood
- Environment Address the causes and impacts of climate change








