## History of South Bellevue Community Center

**1998** - City Council appropriated funds to build a community center in South Bellevue and appointed a Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC).

2000 - Park Board recommended approval of the CAC report.

**2003** - Eastgate Park was transferred from King County to City of Bellevue, which was identified as the location to build a new center.

**2004** - City Council adopted the Eastgate Park Master Plan and on August 16 held a groundbreaking ceremony.

**December 3, 2005** - SBCC opened with a Grand Opening Celebration event.



## Response to COVID pandemic

- 1. Boys and Girls Clubs of Bellevue used SBCC as a childcare facility
- 2. Pivot to virtual programming
  - 3 different virtual fitness classes with students from around world
  - A weekly fitness fun video (for inspiration/motivation & a little humor)
  - Preschool story time with Natural Start Preschool & the Bellevue Fire Department
- 3. Reset programs/activities
  - Staff used time to plan strategically & with intention
  - Days/Times, Well-rounded programming, Inclusion/Accessibility, Diversity & Equity
- 4. Re-opening safely and slowly since February 2021
  - In compliance with Governors ever changing guidelines
  - Signage, masking, group sizes, vaccination verification, facility flow etc.
- 5. Program growth
  - Fitness classes: There were 68 classes a week offered pre-covid currently offering 32 per-week, comparing the 32 classes; registration is at 70% of pre-covid
  - Fitness Center: ePass memberships are at 55% of pre-covid memberships
  - Drop-In sports: Q2 2019 = 3,198 participants, Q2 2022 = 3,319


- Expand existing programs through marketing and social media
