and rolling, and the health benefits related to physical activity; and

safely walk or roll to school or to the school bus and in creating and promoting local Safe

Routes to School Programs across the United States and globally; and

Whereas: Walking or rolling as modes of transportation can relieve traffic congestion and offer

environmental benefits; and

Whereas: This year's walk and roll event is coordinated by Bellevue SchoolPool, a collaboration

between Bellevue, King County Metro and Bellevue School District, to encourage families

and students to explore sustainable transportation options;
