What is a Micro-Apartment?

- Small studio/loft apartment (includes kitchen & bathroom)
- Near jobs, transit, shopping, and services
- Lower cost rentals (typically \$900-\$1,500)
- Typical residents:
 - Students/ young professionals
 - People in transition
 - Retirees

AHS Strategy B: Create A Variety of Housing Choices

- Offer more types of housing, including lower priced options near jobs, transit, shopping, and services
- Action B-1: Encourage microapartments around light rail stations through actions such as reduced parking requirements

LUCA Objectives

Objective: remove barriers to construction of micro-apartments


- Few micro-apartments existing in Bellevue
- Due to small unit size, micro-apartments have tighter profit margins
- Added costs towards production from:
 - Not enough density
 - High minimum parking
 - Residential amenities

Proposed Scope

- Establish maximum floor area requirements
- Determine accessibility needs
- Amend LUC requirements, such as:
 - Density limits (number of DU/ac)
 - Parking requirements
 - Residential amenity requirements

Geographic Scope

- Location: All mixed-use land use districts
- Purpose: Enables micro-apartments in areas near jobs, transit, shopping, and services



Public Engagement

Proposed modes of outreach:

- Process IV Requirements: Planning Commission meetings, noticing and public hearing
- Direct Engagement and Feedback: One-on-one conversations, stakeholder meetings
- Online Presence: City webpage to provide opportunities for the public to stay informed and to request additional information
