ORDINANCE NO. 6685

AN ORDINANCE (1) authorizing an amendment to a subgrantee agreement with the Dispute Resolution Center of Kitsap County, as lead fiscal agent for Resolution Washington, to accept an additional \$140,511.02 in grant funding from the Washington State Department of Commerce (under state contract S22-31445-001), for staffing and administrative costs at the Bellevue Conflict Resolution Center during state fiscal year 2022 to 2023; and (2) amending the 2021-2022 Operating Grants, Donations and Special Reserves Fund to increase the appropriation by \$79,397.

The City Manager, or his designee, is authorized to execute an amendment to a sub-grantee agreement, previously executed (under Ordinance 6602), with the Dispute Resolution Center of Kitsap County, as lead fiscal agent for Resolution Washington, to accept an additional \$140,511.02 in grant funding from the Washington State Department of Commerce (under state contract S22-31445-001), for staffing and administrative costs at the Bellevue Conflict Resolution Center during state fiscal year 2022 to 2023, a copy of which sub-contract has been given Clerk's Receiving No.
