NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the **Bellevue City Council** will hold a public hearing during its Regular Meeting on **Monday, November 7, 2022**, to consider the City of Bellevue's Proposed Modifications to the 2023-2024 Budget and 2023-2029 Capital Investment Program (CIP) Plan Mid-Biennium Update, including all proposed levies, taxes, fees, and rates. The meeting begins at **6:00 PM** and the agenda for the meeting will be published on or about **November 3, 2022**. The meeting will be conducted in a hybrid manner with options to attend both in-person and virtually via Zoom Webinar. The public hearing will be the third and final public hearing opportunity for residents and other stakeholders to offer comment on the development of the City's 2023-2024 Budget and 2023-2029 Capital Investment Program (CIP) Plan, including all levies, taxes, fees, and rates. This hearing, as well as the two additional public hearings (held in May and August), represent a series of important opportunities for the public to let the Council know what is important to fund and what is less important. At all public hearings on the City's 2023-2024 Budget and 2023-2029 Capital Investment Program (CIP) Plan, the public is invited to provide testimony on the operating and capital budgets, including possible future proposed levies, taxes, fees, and rates.
