

Supports the USDOT's National Roadway Safety Strategy: zero deaths and serious injuries on our nation's roadways.



Implementation Grants



B-SAFE: Data Informed



- ➤ The B-SAFE project area is only 12% of Bellevue's geography but represents:
 - 62% of citywide transit usage
 - **58%** of citywide jobs
 - **57%** of B-SAFE project area residents are People of Color
 - **48%** of the citywide High Injury Network
 - **40%** of the city's pedestrian and bicyclist involved fatal and serious injury collisions


