

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 6702

AN ORDINANCE amending Ordinance No. 6622, adopted November 22, 2021 and previously amended, to amend the 2021-2022 Budget by increasing the General Self Insurance Fund appropriation by \$400,000 to reflect actual costs of liability claims made against the City, purchase of commercial insurance coverage, and administrative costs.

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 6622 adopted on November 22, 2021, the City Council adopted a fiscal biennium budget and appropriated funds to the General Self Insurance Fund; and

WHEREAS, over the course of the 2021-2022 biennium, the city has incurred higher than expected costs related to claim expenses and settlements, costs related to contracting external legal services, and insurance costs; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to further amend the 2021-2022 biennium budget to increase appropriation to the General Self Insurance Fund to reflect the costs incurred.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 6622, adopted November 22, 2021 and previously amended, is hereby amended to increasing the General Self Insurance Fund appropriation by \$400,000.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive the monies anticipated herein and to expend the same.

Section 3. Severability. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining parts or this Ordinance.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.
