PROJECT UPDATES

GENERAL

Public Art CIP Fund

Update: The approved 2023-2024 Bellevue City budget includes increases to our Public Art CIP fund. The current annual allocation of \$350K per year will increase to \$500K in 2023, then increases by \$50K every two years until it reaches \$650K per year in 2028.

Cultural Facility CIP Fund

Update: New in 2023, the Cultural Facility CIP Fund will now be administered by Arts Program staff. This fund also received a substantial increase in funding from \$200K per year to \$962K per year through 2027 and \$2.4M in 2028 and 2029. In 2023 Staff will research cultural facility grant programs and come to the Arts Commission with options.

2023 Arts Grants Funding

Update: During the Public Hearing on the 2023-2024 City Budget, Council heard public comments supporting increased funding to the Arts Grants. In response, Council has approved a one-time conversation of \$85K from CIP funds to the Arts Grants. Staff will return to Commission in 2023 with a plan for fund disbursement.

2022 Arts Grant Funding Cycle and Allocations Committee

Update: The 2022 Funding Cycle closed in November, and staff are working on getting payment sent to all awardees.

2023 Arts Grant Funding Cycle and Allocations Committee

Update: The Bellevue City Council is scheduled to be presented with the Allocations Committee recommendations for 2023 awards on December 5th.
