Background

- City Council identified Safe Parking as a priority Council item for 2021-2023
 - "Council Priority #17: Explore a safe parking program for homelessness response."
- Council directed staff to develop an implementation plan during July 11th, 2022 Council meeting
- \$450,000/yr. for Safe Parking pilot included in 2023-2024 Budget

Program Development

- Livable City Year project (2019)
- Vehicle Residency Safe Parking Alternatives Memo (2022)
- Staff conducted outreach to vehicle residents, current safe parking programs, and prospective safe parking program facilitators (2022)
- Staff surveyed potential sites, ultimately deciding on the Lincoln Center (2022)
- Staff developed a program model, and drafted a Request for Proposal (2022)



Lincoln Center

- An ideal safe parking site has:
 - Daily living facilities
 - Ample parking space
 - Relative seclusion
- The Lincoln Center has each desired characteristic



Program Details

- Program purpose: find stable housing for vehicle residents.
- Population served: vehicular residents in any vehicle, passenger or RV, that they own
- Program operator will be required to develop:
 - A safety plan
 - A code of conduct for participants

Satellite Safe Parking

- Continuation of Livable City Year Safe Parking Work in 2018-2019
- Safe Parking Facilitator will offer support to potential additional safe parking facilities operated by religious properties
- Would allow additional safe parking sites to serve especially vulnerable populations, such as families with children.
