RESOLUTION NO. 10214

A RESOLUTION determining that an existing water easement at 14121 NE 20th Street is surplus to the City's needs and is no longer required for providing continued water service; and setting a time and place for a public hearing to consider the release of this easement.

WHEREAS, on January 10, 1983 the City was granted a water easement on the property located at 14121 NE 20th Street in Bellevue, Washington, bearing King County Recording Number 8302180654; and

WHEREAS, the owner of the property subject to the easement has requested the City release the existing easement bearing King County Recording Number 8302180654 (as depicted on Attachment A) because it interferes with the redevelopment of the property; and

WHEREAS, the Bellevue Utilities Department has verified and confirmed that the aforementioned easement is no longer required to provide continued public utility services; and

WHEREAS, based on the foregoing, the existing easement (as depicted on Attachment A) is no longer needed by the City and is otherwise a surplus property interest; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Bellevue City Code 4.32.070 and RCW 35.94.040, the City Council desires to set a time and place for a public hearing to consider the release of said easement; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Pursuant to Bellevue City Code 4.32.070 and RCW 35.94.040, the City Council of the City of Bellevue does hereby declare the existing water easement bearing King County Recording Number 8302180654 (as depicted on Attachment A) as surplus to the needs of the City.

Section 2. A public hearing shall be held upon the proposal to release the easement set forth in Section 1, on February 13, 2023, at 6:00 pm or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard by the City Council, at Bellevue City Hall, 450 110th Avenue NE, Bellevue, Washington and virtually via Zoom Webinar. Details on how to provide written or oral communications at the public hearing will be provided on the published agenda.
