

## **Location Details**

- An ideal safe parking site has:
  - Daily living facilities
  - Ample parking space
  - Relative seclusion
- The Lincoln Center has each desired characteristic



# **Program Details**

 Program purpose: find stable housing for vehicle residents.

 Population served: vehicular residents in any vehicle that they own

# **Program Details (Continued)**

- Program operator will be required to develop:
  - A safety plan
  - A code of conduct for participants

 Referrals for program will come from City staff

# Satellite Safe Parking

 Safe Parking Program Operator will offer support to potential additional safe parking facilities operated by religious properties

 Satellite safe parking sites can serve especially vulnerable populations, such as families with children.
