## ORDINANCE NO. 6725

AN ORDINANCE 1) authorizing execution of a grant agreement (and supplements if necessary) with the Washington State Transportation Improvement Board (TIB) to accept up to \$3,990,000 in state Urban Arterial Program (UAP) grant funding to support construction of the 150<sup>th</sup> Avenue SE Mobility Improvements (SE 28<sup>th</sup> Street to SE 38<sup>th</sup> Street) Project (reference CIP Plan No. PW-R-212, 150<sup>th</sup> Avenue SE/SE 37th Street/I-90 EB offramp); 2) amending the 2023-2029 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) Plan to increase the budget for the 150<sup>th</sup> Avenue SE/SE 37th Street/I-90 EB off-ramp (CIP Plan No. PW-R-212) by \$3,990,000; and, 3) amending the 2023-2024 General CIP Fund to increase the appropriation by \$3,990,000.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute a grant agreement (and supplements if necessary) with the Washington State Transportation Improvement Board (TIB) to accept up to \$3,990,000 in state Urban Arterial Program (UAP) grant funding to support construction of the 150<sup>th</sup> Avenue SE Mobility Improvements (SE 28<sup>th</sup> Street to SE 38<sup>th</sup> Street) Project (reference CIP Plan No. PW-R-212, 150<sup>th</sup> Avenue SE/SE 37th Street/I-90 EB off-ramp), a copy of which grant agreement shall be substantially in the form given Clerk's Receiving No.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said grant agreement.

Section 3. The City Manager or his designee shall have responsibility for the administration of said funds and expenditure of said funds received pursuant to said grant agreement and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 4. The 2023-2029 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) Plan adopted by Ordinance No. 6698 on November 21, 2022, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the budget for the 150<sup>th</sup> Avenue SE/SE 37th Street/I-90 EB off-ramp (CIP Plan No. PW-R-212) by \$3,990,00.

Section 5. The 2023-2024 General CIP Fund adopted by Ordinance No. 6698 on November 21, 2022, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the appropriation by \$3,990,000.

Section 6. If the actual revenue received from Washington State Transportation Improvement Board shall be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriation to the CIP Plan and Fund shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 7. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.
