My name is Matthew Sadowski, an avid golfer and regular patron at the Bellevue Municipal golf course. I moved to Seattle about 4 years ago and have since found the Bellevue golf course to not only be an enjoyable place to play and practice the game of golf but a place of community where people of all ages can gather. Playing at the course over the past few seasons observed an increase in practice and play which is great to see - not only for the game and the youth that is picking it up, but for the city and its parks as well. The reason I'm writing is because I'm interested in understanding more about the amount of revenue that the municipal course generates for the city and what percentage of that is reinvested into the course for maintenance and redevelopment. I'd like to make sure that I emphasize that the course is maintained quite well for the staff and resources allocated, however, given the revenue I anticipate the course generates, I think there is room for improvement. Does your commission or the city council generate a financial report that states the revenue generated by each of the city parks as well as the amount invested into maintaining or redeveloping each park including the Bellevue municipal golf course? Can you please link me to it?

Additionally, while I was able to find the meeting minutes for the Jan 10th, 2023 meeting, I wasn't able to find the scheduled meeting for February. In your reply, can you please let me know the date, time, and location of the February meeting so that we can discuss (or at least hear further) in person?
