

Procurement and Real Property


Desired Outcomes

- Streamlined, consistent processes
- Create efficiency/reduce volume
- Maintain oversight of significant expenditures
- Ensure transparency
- Faster project delivery for community

Proposed threshold

- Increase threshold from \$90K to \$350K for Procurement and Real Property
- Factors considered:
 - State Law
 - Volume of Contracts
 - Thresholds for Other Agencies

Contract Volume vs. Contract Value



Procurement Thresholds for other Agencies

Jurisdiction	Threshold for Council/Board approval
Bellevue	>\$90,000
Tacoma	>\$500,000
Seattle	No threshold
King County	No threshold
Port of Seattle	>\$2,000,000 (effective April 3, 2023)
Bellevue	>\$300,000 – Public Works
School District	No threshold (if within approved budget) – all
	other purchases
Sound Transit	>\$5,000,000 – Construction, A&E
	>\$2,000,000 – all other purchases

Supporting Code Revisions

- Clarify administrative authority
- Fix outdated or incorrect references
- Consolidate threshold for Real Property "small purchases"
- Adjust settlement thresholds for low dollar Real Property transactions

- Faster delivery of projects under \$350K
- Improved efficiency for Staff and Council
- Maintains our commitments to competition, fairness and strong internal controls
- Transparency through reporting on contracts between \$90K and \$350K

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
