## CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

## ORDINANCE NO. 6726

AN ORDINANCE amending the 2023-2024 budget to increase appropriations to the Operating Grants, Donations, and Special Reserves Fund by \$100,974 to reflect the amount to be spent through the Washington State Department of Commerce Middle Housing Grant in 2023; providing for severability; and establishing an effective date.

## THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as memorialized in Resolution 10158 and the attendant Interagency Agreement between the City and Washington State Department of Commerce, and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 2. Ordinance No. 6698, adopted on November 21, 2022 and previously amended, is hereby amended to increase the 2023-2024 budget by increasing appropriations to the Operating Grants, Donations and Special Reserves Fund by \$100,974 in anticipated grant funds from the Washington State Department of Commerce.

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the anticipated source specified in said Interagency Agreement shall be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriations shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 4. <u>Severability</u>. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining parts of this Ordinance.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.
