ORDINANCE NO. 6727

AN ORDINANCE 1) authorizing execution of an Electric Fire Apparatus Grant Program Agreement with the State of Washington Department of Ecology to accept grant funds up to \$648,578.63 for the purchase of an electric fire engine and associated infrastructure; and 2) amending the 2023-2024 Operating Grants, Donations, and Special Reserves Fund to increase appropriation by \$648,578.63.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute a grant agreement with State of Washington Department of Ecology to accept grant funds up to \$648,578.63 for the purchase of an electric fire engine and associated infrastructure, a copy of which grant agreement shall be substantially in the form given Clerk's Receiving No. ______.
- Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are herby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said Grant Agreement.
- Section 3. The City Manager of designee shall have responsibility for the administration of said funds and expenditure of said funds received pursuant to said Grant Agreement and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.
- Section 4. At the time of execution of said Grant Agreement and acceptance of funds, a project shall be established within the Operating Grants, Donations and Special Reserves Fund into which all said respective grant monies shall be deposited.
- Section 5. The approximate amount and anticipated source of revenue for the said grant monies is:

State of Washington Department of Ecology up to \$648,578.63

Section 6. Upon execution of said Grant Agreement, the budget for the 2023-2024 Operating Grants, Donations and Special Reserves Fund shall be amended by appropriating up to \$648,578.63 to said fund.

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the anticipated source specified in said Grant Agreement shall be more of less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriations shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 7. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after spassage and legal publication.	•
