I read this commentary piece about the great downtown park with a sense of civic pride. But I also thought of the sign saying a 21-story high rise, Park Row, would be built directly abutting the eastern park border.

No other buildings abut the park - certainly not a 21-story high-rise. Such an edifice will significantly and forever degrade the personality of the park and the city. Clearly, the building code should have carved out a more sensitive exception for those parcels that would not allow such a building to be park-adjacent.

The Seattle Times piece applauds the civic leadership of 40 years ago to make the park a reality. I urge you to show similar leadership to preserve and enhance the park. Rather than allow the high-rise condo there, the city should use eminent domain to buy that parcel of land and make it a new grand vista and entryway to the park.
