

Capital and Operations & Maintenance/Services Funding

• Process:

- Annual RFP coordinated with other funding sources
- City of Bellevue/ARCH partnership
- Funding Priorities:
 - Prevent homelessness and housing instability
 - 0-30 percent AMI
 - Vulnerable, underserved populations





Capital and Operations & Maintenance/Services Funding

2021 Process

- RFP for up to \$6M
- 3 applications

2021 Awards

- \$1.6M award to LifeWire
- Financing closed; construction underway

2022 Process

- RFP for up to \$10.5M
- 4 applications

Over \$30M in requests \$6.8M recommended for awards, with additional five-year O&M/services

commitments

Unallocated funds rollover to 2023 RFP
