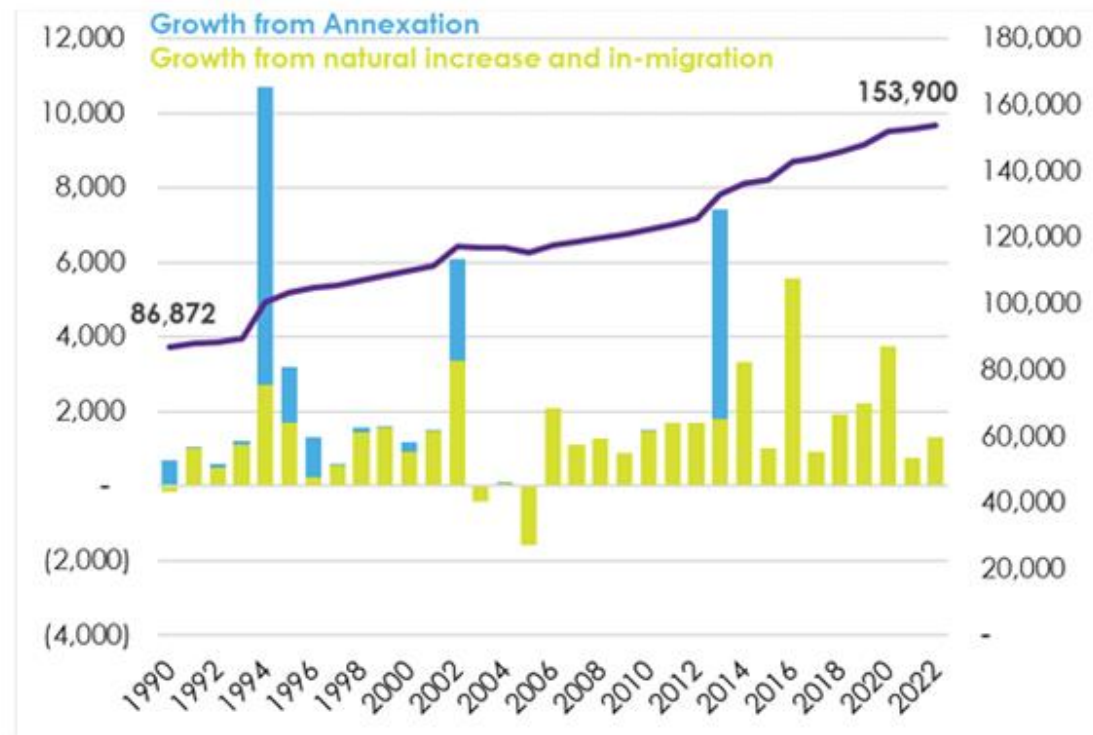

Exhibit 2. Historic Population, Bellevue, 1990 – 2020



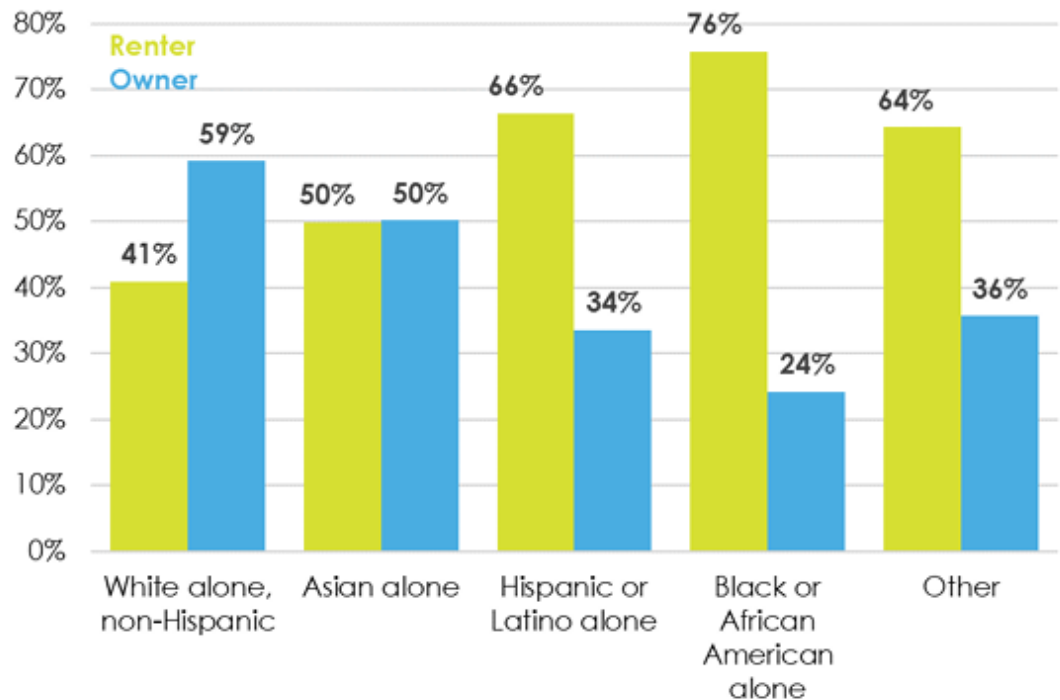

A significantly smaller share of Black or African American and Hispanic or Latino households own their home.

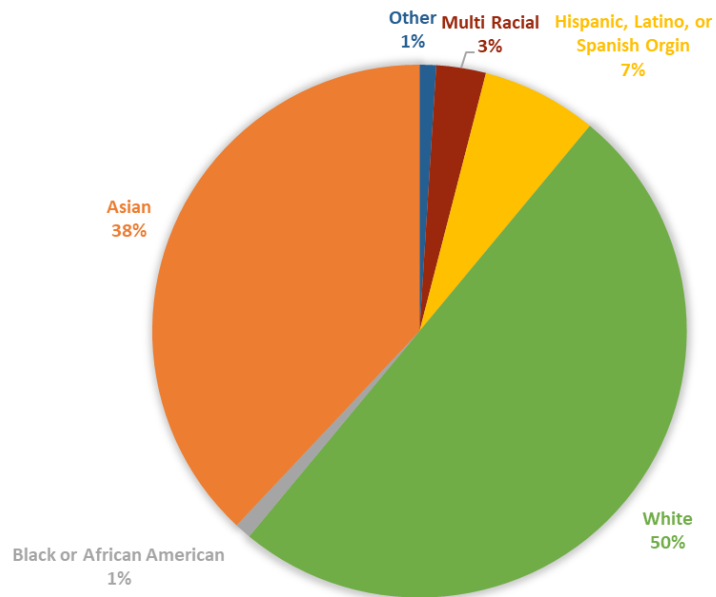
Exhibit 21. Households by Race and Tenure, Bellevue, 2020



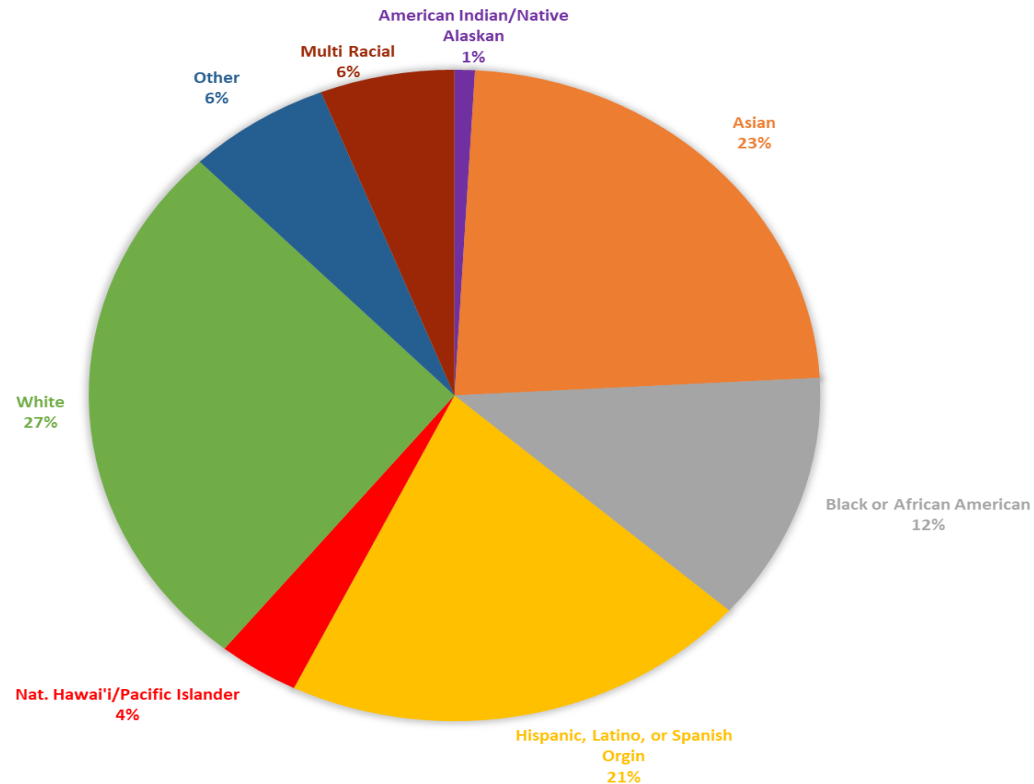
