State Legislative Session Update: Staff has provided a written summary of recently-completed state legislative session, which adjourned on April 23. It includes analysis and status of a variety of bills of interest to Bellevue and to cities more broadly. Staff are providing a 2023 State Legislative Session Wrap-Up Summary separately as a study session.

Federal Legislative Update: Staff has provided a written summary of recent activities of the Congress and Administration. Congress is moving ahead with its congressionally directed spending process, which Bellevue is participating in. Staff is drafting a revised set of 2024 federal priorities for consideration in early summer.
