

CITY COUNCIL AGENDA MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT

Resolution No. 8894 authorizing execution of a four-year Interlocal Agreement between Bellevue and the cities and organizations of Kirkland, Mountlake Terrace, Port of Seattle, Renton, SeaTac, Tacoma, Tukwila, Woodinville, Seattle Parks and Recreation, University of Washington, USDA Wildlife Services, Washington State Parks, and the US Fish and Wildlife Service for waterfowl management.

FISCAL IMPACT

This agreement will obligate the City to the amount of \$2,230 for 2015 with an approximate total of \$8,920 for the four-year term. Over the subsequent three years, this amount could increase or decrease approximately 5% depending on the number of participants. There are sufficient funds budgeted in the 2015-2016 Parks and Community Services Department Operating Budget for the first two years of the agreement. Future costs associated with this agreement will be requested in subsequent operating budgets and will be subject to final budget appropriation.

POLICY CONSIDERATION

This agreement provides for continued regional cooperative efforts to control waterfowl populations, provide public and agency education, and population data collection.

BACKGROUND

Since 1987, the City has actively participated on the Seattle Metropolitan Waterfowl Management Committee. This committee, comprised of local government agencies and private companies, provides direct financial support to USDA Wildlife Services Agency to achieve the regional goals of the committee.

The purpose of this Agreement is to provide joint funding for an egg addling program and population monitoring and census, mainly of Canada geese, within King and Snohomish counties. This program will assist each party in communicating, maintaining, and managing both public as well as selected and approved private site impacts of excessive waterfowl.

EFFECTIVE DATE

If approved by Council, this Resolution will become effective immediately. The term of this Agreement is January 1, 2015 to December 31, 2018.

OPTIONS

1.
